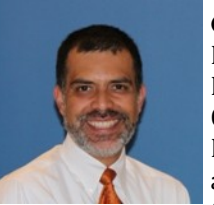

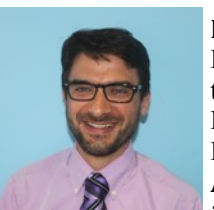
because of her commitment to working with the underserved and improving the health and quality of life of children from underserved communities like the one in which she grew up.

Cheryl Focht, MD, MPH

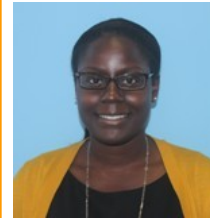
